Mahr Entry Sign

Be on the lookout for dirt work and construction to begin soon with our entry sign! We are thankful for the generous investment from the Mahr Charitable Trust to complete this essential project that will allow guests better visibility and ease in locating the Arboretum and honoring the beautiful legacy of Dr. Merle and Glema Mahr. The entry sign features unique design elements that connect the park's natural features and branding standards. The sign will have two pristine water features, natural stone, and lush plants, standing at 17 feet on the rear column. The sign will genuinely honor the Mahrs and allow guests ease of locating their destination. The project will begin dirt work within the next few weeks, with construction starting shortly after. After project completion, a dedication will be announced

Enjoy the view from a new pedal boat. Rentals are \$15/ hour and are available at our Welcome Center. Lifejacket included with a rental.


